Host Site Requirements

Live Stream Requirements

- A dedicated hard-wired internet connection is required with a download speed of 20mb or more.
 - Please utilize a separate connection from your standard guest WIFI. We want to have the best experience for guests as possible without any buffering issues due to network congestion.
 - The day of the event, please use an internet speed test to confirm you are receiving the appropriate speed. We recommend speedtest.net.
- Projection
 - A video screen that is large enough for the estimated number of attendees is required.
 - Due to social distancing concerns, you may need a larger screen than in a “normal” setting so everyone can see and experience the conference
 - This screen can be a large format TV, LED wall, or Video Projector.
 - The stream can be played through any web browser, Safari, Firefox, or Chrome.
 - If you are using dual screens, the browser window will need to be dragged to the other window and maximized approximately 30-60 minutes before the start of the event.
- Audio
 - Musical worship will be a vital component of the 360 Man Conference. We ask that your video projection system be connected to your Front of House Audio system at the host site with the ability to be loud enough for attendees to freely worship.
- Testing
 - You must access the test stream the week before the event and contact the Conference Production Team should you experience any issues.

Conference Help

The conference will play from a dedicated video host and you will be supplied the direct link for your browser approximately 1 week before the event. Our technical team will be available the week before the event to test your connection to our private server.

We do not anticipate any issues on the day of the event if we all do our due diligence in pre-conference tests. Should an issue arise, you will contact Scott Ball at 443.466.5979 via phone or text and we will work to troubleshoot the issues.
